QUEBEC CITY, CANADA

Québec City's alluring setting atop Cape Diamond evokes a past of high adventure, military history, and exploration. Visitors come for the delicious and inventive cuisine, the remarkable historical continuity, and to share in the seasonal exuberance of the largest Francophone population outside France. The historic heart of this community is the Old City, comprising the part of Upper Town surrounded by walls and Lower Town, which spreads out at the base of the hill from Place Royale. Cobblestone streets, horse-drawn carriages, and elaborate cathedrals here are charming in all seasons.



NEW YORK, USA

From Wall Street's skyscrapers to the neon of Times Square to Central Park's leafy paths, New York City pulses with an irrepressible energy.
